

AGREED FINAL ORDER

This matter came on for hearing on September 30, 1987, upon the Commission's February 11, 1987, Interlocutory Order which modified, in part, the Commission's March 26, 1987, Order.

Whereupon counsel for the parties represented that they had reached an accord on the sole issue to be heard, that being the amount of back wages due the complainant "amounting to the difference between the complainant's actual pay and what he would have earned as a corporal from January 31, 1975 to April 1978." The parties placed their agreement on this issue on the record, stating that Mr. Brown would receive \$5,778.63 if paid on or before October 1, 1987, which amount represented said pay back plus interest in accordance with the Commission's February 11, 1987 Order. The parties further represented that this amount had been paid to complainant at the time of entry of this Order.

Therefore, in accordance with the Commission's March 27, 1986, Order and the Interlocutory Order of February 11, 1987, it is hereby ORDERED that the "Respondent pay to Complainant compensatory damages for humiliation, embarrassment, emotional distress and loss of personal dignity in the amount of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars", and that all other terms of the Commission's Orders of March 27, 1986, and February 11, 1987, shall apply.


